DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Pastor Byron opens the message discussing how the Word of God provides encouragement, clarity, and comfort in our lives? Can you share a specific example?
2. He also mentions that the Bible often leads us to encouragement through the uncomfortable path of correction. Can you share a time when you experienced this in your spiritual journey?
3. What does it mean to look at politics through a Biblical lens rather than looking at the Bible through a political lens? How can we apply this principle in our daily lives?
4. The message states that "**disagreement is inevitable, division is a choice.**" How can we navigate political disagreements within our faith community without causing division? What strategies can we use to maintain unity?
